Presentation of the DGA, DA and the AIA. Information sharing on status of “Competent bodies” at national level for the implementation of forthcoming EU regulations.	<p>After short presentations intended to give an overview of the three regulations, the delegates gave their points of view through a tour de table, based on the background questions distributed before the meeting.</p> <p>It was agreed that</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The task regarding the implementation of the Single Digital Gateway was to be deprioritized for the time being, based on amongst others the ongoing “Single Digital Gateway Once Only Principle Proof of Concept Pilots Project” under the Cross-Border Digital Service- Program.¹- As the Artificial Intelligence Act and Data Act is still not adopted, the focus should be on the Data Governance Act for the time being. <p>The different input and contributions given through this session will form a basis and direction for the networks further work.</p>
Introduction and discussion of Digitalisation- and automatisisation ready legislation.	<p>The same applies for the afternoon session on digitalisation- and automatization ready legislation. The conversations held after the presentation was aimed at identifying any shared understanding, as well as exchanging knowledge on different national models, which may feed into national deliberations.</p> <p>The last session concentrated on framework and formalities for the network to work under. It was agreed that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The network reports to the HNG of the Nordic Council of Ministers, MR-Digital.2. The PL shared the Project Description to the NCMs.3. Meetings will be planned as presented during the meeting, e.g., three physical meeting to be arranged throughout 2023, preferably adjacent to relevant arrangements in Europe.4. No documents or other in formation will go out from the group without prior, unanimous consent from all participants in the network.
Way forward: Next meetings, expectations on participation from the delegates.

Minutes from meetings will be short, while notes taken by the PL (or his associates) will be used as background for a final report. 6. We all recognise that this is not a political network, and that positions stated through the meeting, is not necessarily national positions. That said, and in referral to point 4, all statements in the final report should be nationally anchored. 7. Members can draw on internal resources in this network if they see fit for purpose, e.g., when discussing more in details, special competences are welcome to join meetings. 8.
